

Environmental Impact Statement stakeholder engagement

Both ocean and land-based studies will be undertaken to evaluate the most appropriate tailings management option for the Wafi-Golpu Project. These options will also be subject to community consultation and the evaluation and feedback will be documented in the Environmental Impact Statement for the Government's further consideration.



Stakeholder engagement

- The project is committed to establishing an ongoing relationship with communities and stakeholders.
- Public roadshows will be held in communities both prior to and following the submission of both the Environmental Inception Report and Environmental Impact Statement. These roadshows will present the results of environmental and social investigations and invite community feedback and input.
